Pre-arrival procedures

This section explains the steps and procedures that international students must follow before coming to the Kingdom to study at Prince Mugrin bin Abdulaziz University. These procedures help facilitate the transfer process and ensure that the student is properly prepared.

1- Obtaining academic acceptance

Submitting an application for admission to the university and uploading the required documents such as academic certificates, letters of recommendation and CV (for example), and receiving the official acceptance letter.

2- Study Visa

Apply for a study visa from the Saudi embassy and consulate in your country using the acceptance letter from the university and prepare the required documents such as passport and health certificates.

3- Health insurance

Make sure to obtain health insurance that covers the period of your stay in the Kingdom.

4- selecting the accommodation

Search for a suitable accommodation options, whether university accommodation or private accommodation in the surrounding areas, and make arrangements for booking.

5- Open a local bank account .

6- Checking tuition and living expenses requirements .

7- Collect all documents such as: passport, educational certificates, health insurance, personal photos and keep an electronic copies of these documents.

8- Contact the International Students Department to benefit from any additional information or support before arrival.

9- Planning the trip, booking the travel ticket and the transportation before arrival .

10- Prepare appropriate clothes and personal needs which are suitable for the weather conditions .

These procedures helps international students to prepare themselves appropriately before arriving to the university, which contributes to facilitating their study and transition experience to the Kingdom.
