• Study visa requirements in Saudi Arabia

To apply for a Saudi student visa, applicants must meet the following requirements:

1- Passport

The applicant must have a valid passport for six months, from the traveling date to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, with two blank pages facing each other for the official use.

2- Personal Photos

The applicant must submit a recent colored photo on a white background with dimensions of 2×2 inches with a natural facial expressions, with the face representing 80% of the photo. Glasses or head covering are not permitted except for a religious reasons.

3- Sponsorship

The applicant must be accepted and registered with a Saudi educational institution.

4- Visa Referral Notice

The applicant must have a visa referral notice issued by the Saudi Ministry of Foreign Affairs including the visa information's.

5- Birth Certificate

The applicant must have an original birth certificate, in addition to one copy.

6- Graduation Certificate

The applicant must submit a high school certificate in addition to one copy - Please note that high school certificates must be certified by the Saudi Cultural mission .

7- Medical Report

The applicant must submit three copies of a recent medical report issued within the past three months by a licensed physician bearing the physician's license number and address, along with laboratory results proving that the applicant is free from diseases.

8- Criminal Record

The applicant must submit a recent criminal record report issued within a period not exceeding six months prior to applying for a Saudi Student Visa, which shows the applicant's criminal record or no record existence.

9- Visa Application

The applicant must apply for a Saudi Student Visa by filling out the Saudi Student Visa Application Form via the Saudi Ministry of Foreign Affairs portal, then submitting the application and required documents by mail or in person at the nearest Saudi Embassy or Representative Office abroad.

Please note that foreign applicants may be required to purchase medical insurance in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Applying for a Saudi visa for students

To apply for a Saudi visa for students, applicants must follow the following steps:

1. Registration

Apply to a Saudi university or educational program. - Once you are accepted into a Saudi educational program, you can apply for a Saudi student visa.

2. Submit the online application

The foreign student fills out the Saudi student visa application form through the Saudi Ministry of Foreign Affairs portal, which includes personal information and other required information. - Pay the Saudi student visa fees online through the Saudi Ministry of Foreign Affairs portal, using a valid credit or debit card.

3. apply

Submit your Saudi study visa application and required documents by mail or by visiting the nearest Saudi embassy or representative office abroad.

4. Approval

If approved, your Saudi visa can be obtained from the Saudi Embassy or a Representative Office through which you previously applied with . Check that all visa information's are correct and matches the information's in your passport. - Your Saudi Student Visa will be issued with a validity period appropriate to the Saudi educational program you are enrolled in .
